LIST OF INGREDIENTS: Dehydrated alfalfa meal, soybean meal, corn distillers dried grains with solubles, magnesium glycine complex, flaxseed meal, dicalcium phosphate, magnesium oxide, natural and artificial flavoring, soybean oil, saccharin sodium.

DESCRIPTION: Magnesium plays a key role in over 300 enzymatic reactions, including those that control carbohydrate metabolism, protein synthesis, and protection against inflammation and free radical damage. This nutrient is also essential for healthy nerve, muscle, and joint function. EZium provides a highly bioavailable source of Magnesium chelated with the amino acid glycine. The glycine carries and protects the bonded Magnesium, greatly enhancing absorption.

Magnesium deficiencies can be brought on by stress, adrenaline, and physical exertion. Feeding EZium prevents the symptoms of Magnesium deficiency that can lead to poor performance such as hyperexcitability, erratic behavior, muscle cramps, and metabolic disorders. Positive results in deficient horses can generally be seen within one to two weeks.
